

2021 Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF), Summer Award Amounts & Disbursement
Indian River State College is disbursing HEERF funds to eligible IRSC students who completed coursework
this summer in Title IV eligible programs and have a FAFSA on file.

The onetime awards are grants and do not have to be paid back by the student.

Award amounts vary. Maximum awards are \$750 per student; minimum awards are \$450 per student.

Distribution of awards is based on a student's Expected Family Contribution (EFC) calculated in the
FAFSA on file. This means that if a student is eligible for a lot of federal financial aid, they are likely to
receive more CRRSAA funding; likewise, if a student isn't eligible for federal financial aid, they may only
receive the minimum CRRSAA award.
